

TRANSPORTATION PLANNER

The Lackawanna County Regional Planning Commission is seeking an individual to perform transportation planning for Lackawanna County.

Qualifications

A Master's degree in Urban/Transportation Planning and three years experience with one year of direct transportation planning experience or a Bachelor's Degree in Urban/Transportation Planning and five years experience with two years of direct transportation planning experience.

A working knowledge of the various Federal Transportation Bills including ISTEA, TEA-21, NEXTEA and SAFTEA-LU and Pennsylvania Transportation Planning Law. A working knowledge of the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, Act 247 and other planning related laws such as the Storm Water Management Act 167, The Waste Water Facilities Act 537, Erosion and Sedimentation Control Plans, etc.

Responsibilities

- 1) Preparing and completing the work tasks in the Unified Planning Work Program including such items as the Congestion Management Plan, Highway Performance Monitoring System and the Intermodal Management System.
- 2) Developing and updating the Long Range Transportation Plan for all modes of transportation.
- 3) Developing and updating the Transportation Improvement Program and Twelve Year Transportation Plan.
- 4) Preparing the annual Unified Planning Work Program.
- 5) Attending all transportation related meetings including those of the Lackawanna-Luzerne Transportation Study Committees, the Northeastern Pennsylvania Alliance Rural Planning Organization and Focus 81.
- 6) Developing an undertaking any other transportation planning related studies in the county.
