

## West Nile Virus Program Technician

Lackawanna County West Nile Virus Program is an integrated mosquito management program aimed at reducing the threat to public health.

Responsibilities include:

- Protecting the public from mosquito borne disease through county-wide surveillance and control of mosquito populations
- Technician will conduct both adult and larval mosquito surveillance along with the application of mosquito control products as required
- Ability to calculate area and volume in relation to control applications

Successful candidate must possess a Bachelor's Degree in Biology or Environmental Science; equivalent experience may be considered. Must also have basic knowledge of insect morphology and life cycle and possess basic computer skills to enter field data into a state-wide database. Possessing a valid Pennsylvania driver's license is required. Licensing by the PA Dept. of Agriculture may also be required.
